**Project:** **Flow4YU - YoUng Flow** – Network on dialogue between young people and public institutions

---

**Subject:** Local authorities have difficulties in listening and communicating with young generations. There is a lack of channels, tools and methods to stimulate active involvement and participation of young people in the life of the community. Flow4YU aims therefore at establishing a thematic and long-lasting cooperation between towns in the frame of youth policies and particularly at improving communication and relationship between young people and public authorities both at local and European level.

The main specific objectives are:

- promoting an interactive and constructive dialogue, developing more attractive and inclusive communication channels, tool, methods and contents;
- promoting a better knowledge of administrative systems and organisations at local and European level;
- developing a sense of belonging of youngsters in the public institutions as well as promoting an active participation in the civil society and public life.

The project consists of 7 transnational events (coordinating meetings, professional and youth meetings, conferences) involving 432 participants and lasting 24 months of implementation.
